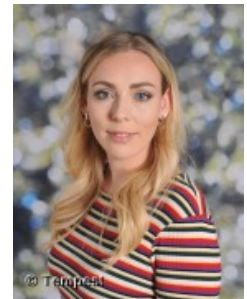


July Newsletter
