Charging and Remissions Policy

Charging

The governors reserve the right to make a charge for activities organised by the school on the following occasions:

- (a) Cost of board and lodging for school residential visits deemed to take place within school hours.
- (b) The full cost of any optional activity undertaken by a pupil, deemed to take place outside school hours.

Remissions

The LEA will remit up to £12.50 of the cost of the board and lodgings for any residential visit deemed to take place in school hours, for pupils whose parents receive Income Support or Family Credit. The governors will remit in full the remainder of any charge for board and lodging. The Governors wish to point out that the school

relies heavily on contributions from parents over and above that which they are bound to pay. Unless the overwhelming majority are willing to pay the full amount of any trip, then trips may have to be cancelled.

Where there are cases of genuine family hardship, making it difficult for pupils to take part in activities for which a charge is made, parents are invited to apply to the Head teacher for help or the remission of the charge in full or in part.
