During the school year we renewed our HX7 membership giving us access to all the local competitions which Gill Bridge organised. These were very well attended by Riverside pupils: we got to the Calderdale finals in Sportshall Athletics, Tennis and XC. In Y5 tennis and KS2 XC our pupils attended the West Yorkshire School Games in Leeds. Our Y6 girls Orienteering team competed in the British Schools Champs in Leeds and 10 pupils competed in the Manchester Schools indoor bouldering competition with more success. Premium money was frequently used on the Community minibus to get us to and from events.

We booked a variety of coaches to work along side staff to improve their teaching skills and confidence: tennis, cricket, fitball, dance Themed days were held which enhanced the curriculum eg skipping and Freddie fit. Y5 took part in an exciting Watersports Day.

Our after school clubs were well attended and frequently subsidised by Sports Premium money. The small minority of children who did not attend a club throughout the year were targeted, with some success.

A large chunk of money was spent on PE resources eg medals, goals, nets, balls, outdoor display signs, Sportshall Athletics equipment etc.

Supply cover was required for some events, mainly for the PE coordinator. It was also used to allow a staff member who previously worked in Outdoor pursuits, to introduce team building activities to each class.

Less money than expected was spent on up skilling staff in PE. This was because 2 courses were cancelled and some staff were not teaching their own PE. This situation will be a big focus for 2015-16 [ PE and Gym training will be in school on training days, other PE training will be out sourced and all staff will teach their own PE]
