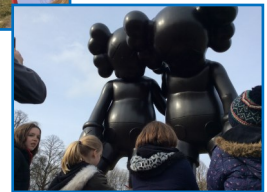
YORKSHIRE MUSEUM

On Monday 29th February our Year 6 children visited Yorkshire Sculpture Park in Wakefield.



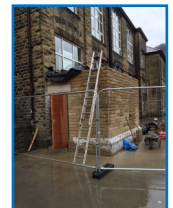
YEAR 5 TRIP TO CLIMBING WALL

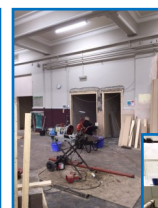
Boiler House
