

PE and Sport Premium Funding at Riverside Junior School

The government gives extra funding to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools. Schools must spend the funding to improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils, but they are free to choose the best way of using the money.

Total funds: £8800 + balance carried over from 2015-16 [post Flooding] £4800 = £13,600
